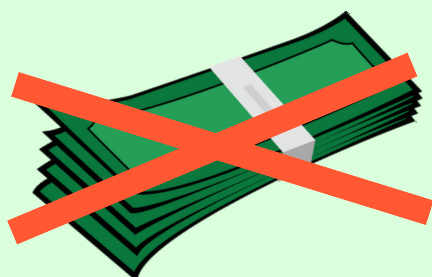

### SUN CREAM & AWARENESS

Can Parents please start providing sun protection, including sun cream, hats & suitable clothing. The general advice is as follows:- Take extra care to protect babies and children. Their skin is much more sensitive than adult skin, and damage caused by repeated exposure to sunlight could lead to skin cancer developing in later life. Children aged under 6 months should be kept out of direct strong sunlight.

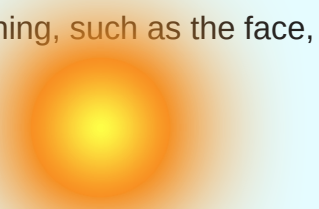
From March to October in the UK, children should:

Cover up with suitable clothing

Spend time in the shade – particularly from 11to 3pm

Wear at least SPF15 sunscreen

Apply sunscreen to areas not protected by clothing, such as the face, ears, feet, and backs of hands.
